

Repstor Drive

Introduction

Repstor drive provides access to any repositories supported by Repstor affinity via Windows Explorer. Users are able to save to Repstor affinity in the standard File->Save dialog of any application, removing the need to move away from the source application in order to add a document to the organization's repository. Repstor affinity automatically synchronizes any changes back to SharePoint or any other supported content repository. Users can easily edit or export information from any repository supported by Repstor affinity using the Explorer file system.

Accessing Drive

Outlook must be running to use Drive. In Windows explorer a new node is added to "My Computer" /"This Pc" called Repstor affinity.



The File Save Dialog will show Repstor Drive as follows.
